

How to register under your ISDN





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Understanding the SSNAP reporting timeline

Example reporting timeline:




SSNAP reporting process summary:

- Clinical teams collect data for each quarter (3 month period)
- Clinical teams have 4 months to collect data for a given quarter.
- To submit data to SSNAP for analysis teams must <u>lock records</u> by the datalocking deadline.
- After the data locking deadline, the SSNAP analysis team export the data and create SSNAP outputs and reports.

Important: SSNAP reporting outputs **SHOULD NOT** be shared outside the NHS until they have been made publicly available. Before being made public, reports can be shared with any appropriate stakeholders such as NHS Area Teams, CSUs and CCGs.



How to download ISDN portfolios

ISDN results portfolios are Excel spreadsheets containing every data item reported by SSNAP as well as a transfer tree, technical guidance and details on case ascertainment and audit compliance for teams in your ISDN. The spreadsheet also includes a national-level and ISDN-level summary column.

ISDN portfolios are produced quarterly.



Understanding ISDN portfolios

Which teams are included?

All teams in your ISDN that have received a named report for the quarter are included.

To get a report:

- Inpatient teams must enter and lock at least 20 records, as well as achieve 75% case ascertainment in a reporting period.
- Community teams must discharge (or transfer) at least 20 records in the period.
- To be included in the national annual report, this figure must be 10 records in a financial year (April-March).

If there are any teams in your ISDN that are not currently participating in SSNAP but could be, <u>click here</u> for a sample email to send to community teams to encourage participation in SSNAP.

What data is included?

The list of data points SSNAP collects can be found in the SSNAP core dataset.

Is any data not included?

Team-level ethnicity data is not reported at ISDN level, however, ethnicity data across the ISDN is reported in the ISDN summary column. Mortality data is not reported at ISDN-level. Scoring has not been made public during the COVID-19 period.

Thrombectomy results are not reported in ISDN-level reports. You can view thrombectomy results for thrombectomy-performing and –referring centres in your ISDN on the SSNAP thrombectomy dashboard. To view the dashboard, go to www.strokeaudit.org > Results Dashboards > Annual Thrombectomy numbers.

If there is too little data for analysis, data points will be replaced with '.' in the portfolio. If there were too few patients for a given measure data will be suppressed (replaced with 'S' in the portfolio).
